

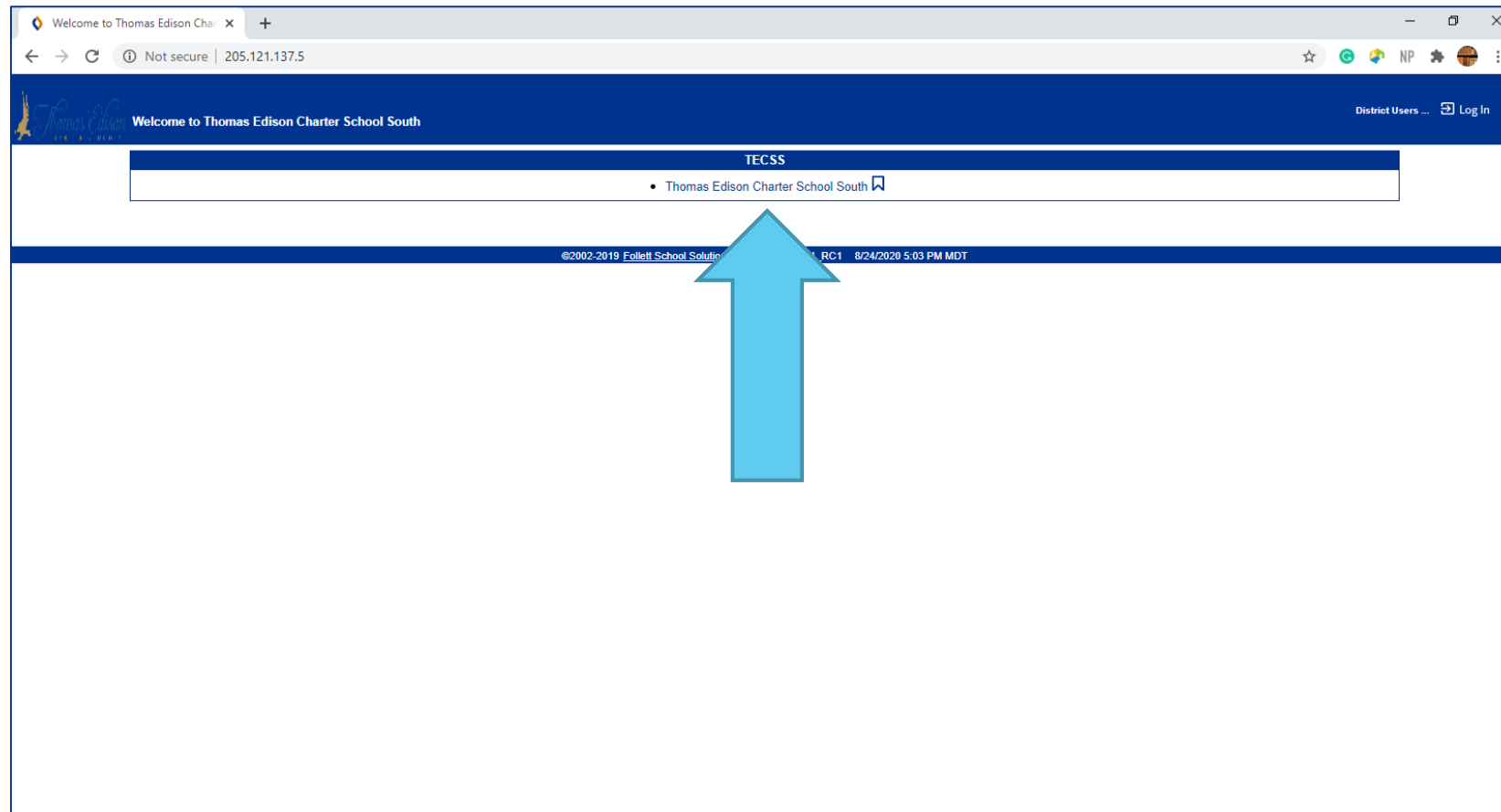
# How to Access Your Destiny Account and Place Holds

Destiny is the software the library uses to catalog books.





# Clicking subject will pull up every book we have in the library about that particular topic. Pay attention to the CALL #



Call numbers that start with numbers are nonfiction.



Call numbers that start with E are picture books, and call numbers that start with FIC are fiction.

The CALL# will help you find the book you want. In this example we searched for owls. Paying attention to the call number will help you find a book that will either help you learn about owls with facts and other interesting information (numbers), or a story about owls (E and FIC).

Destiny requires exact spelling to find the book you are looking for. What if you don't know how to spell the title of a book? No Problem! Spell as much of the title as you can correctly, then use an asterisk\*
