Information for Parents and Students:

- Any students in Kindergarten through grade 5 are eligible to enter, but it is not mandatory.
- Individual, group, and classroom projects are accepted. You may do a project with individuals not in your grade level.
- Each student will be responsible for setting up and taking down their project. Tables will be set up in the cafeteria for projects to be displayed.
- The school will provide electrical outlets for projects, but will not provide running water, drainage, or facilities for gas or compressed air. Dangerous chemicals, open flames, and explosives may not be exhibited. All projects must be durable and safe.
- Any projects deemed to be unsafe or inhumane in any way will not be displayed at the Science Fair. Live animals cannot be exhibited, but photographs are acceptable.
- The project must clearly be the students own effort. If adult support is given, it should be acknowledged on the display.
- Projects should follow the scientific method. Journals are encouraged.
- One *Summary of Project* form must be completed and returned to the front cubby marked “Science Fair” by **Friday, January 18th**.
