Counseling Report – Jamin Bingham:

Sarahann Delany will be the counselor at Edison South. The information in the packet is from last year's counselor.

- Both schools passed the state review that is done every 6 years. They were very impressed with the program.
- The Safe Utah app was implemented for middle school.
- The new health classes will include suicide prevention for students.
- Suicide prevention was taught for staff
- Both schools held a college week with the highlight being an Eldon the Eagle dance off.
- Citizenship parties Edison South movie and the Fun Park, Edison North ski day and the Fun Park.
- The counselors collected data on the confidence students have in paying for college.

DIBELS training – Angela Barton:

The DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) test is reported on 3 times per year. There are five essential skills for early literacy: Phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension. The state requires that students in grades 1-3 be tested. They also pay for kindergarten testing.

At-risk students are monitored for progress on a regular basis. The DIBELS scores are strongly predictive of reading success.

Finance Reports – Jim/Emily/Chris:

Jim explained the budget forms to the new board members.

Principal Reports:

Melani Kirk:

- Projected enrollment was 756, however, it is currently 706. There are still new parents showing interest daily.
- Summer school and Spalding training went well. Teacher training is in progress.
- There are still 7 or 8 employees that need to be hired.
- The parking lot will be done before school begins. Brad has been working with them all summer and is in the process of reworking the pickup drop off guidelines.

Shem Smith:

- Strategic outcome #7 lists the desire to pay off loans by 2020. If it had not been for the need to expand the parking lot, this goal would have been met.
- Summer school served a record number of students
- Second grade went from 60 to 50 students. It sometimes happens, but fills back up.
